이외, 한국어와 영어로 동시 진행되는 학생 주관 교내 각종 행사 및 프로그램, 친구들과 함께 문제를 해결하는 Research Program, 부족한 교과를 상호 보완하는 Peer Tutoring 등을 실시하고 있습니다.

Korean Community in Singapore

According to the Embassy of the Republic of Korea, approximately 21,400 Koreans live in Singapore, making Singapore the world's 18th largest Korean diaspora community. The size of the community noticeably grew between 2005 and 2007 and has remained stable since then. Singapore Korean International School (SKIS) was established in 1993 and is the only school in Singapore that has been founded and is run by Koreans.

School History

Singapore Korean School was established with only 58 students and 6 elementary school teachers. Three-quarters of its classes were conducted in Korean with the remainder conducted in English like other overseas Korean schools.

In 2011, the school changed its name to Singapore Korean International School (SKIS) and opened a middle school for grades 7, 8 and 9. Under a new curriculum, SKIS began to conduct roughly 75% of its class hours in English and Chinese and the remaining 25% in Korean. In March 2012, SKIS opened a high school for grades 10 and 11. Grade 12 was added in 2013, and the first senior class graduated in February 2014.

Evaluation System

Along with regular performance tests, SKIS Middle & High School students take two major tests per semester: a midterm test and a final test.

Grading System

SKIS Middle & High School uses a 100-point numerical grading system for general courses. Korean, mathematics, social studies, and science follow the grading system below.

Letter and Grade-point Equivalents

- ▶ Unlike other Korean schools, SKIS divides its English(G7-12) and Chinese courses(G7-11) into three levels.
- ▶ Students can choose from a variety of electives within a subject group. These courses are open to any number of students.

English, Chinese, Social Studies (Geography), Science (Physics, Chemistry) Physics I , Chemistry I , AP Human Geography, AP Physics, AP Chemistry

ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS

Admission to Grade 7 - 12 is designed to ensure that students who are accepted into the school have the capacity to thrive within and benefit from all that SKIS offers. The admission procedures take into account previous school records, tests in mathematics and English, and an interview.

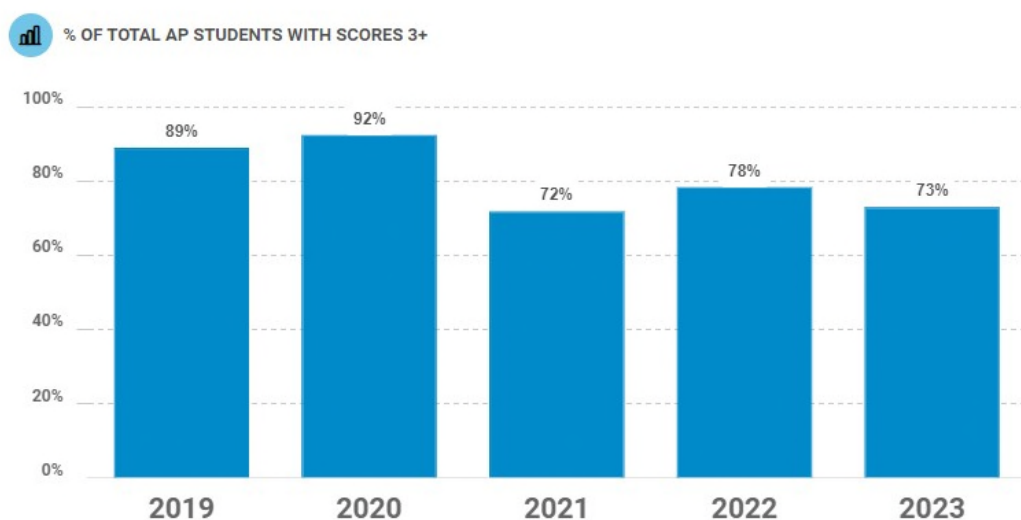
In 2024, SKIS is offering 7 AP subjects on campus to high school students. The courses have been adjusted to fit the school's curriculum.

SKIS ACADEMIC PROGRAM

Academic Calendar

There are 181 school days divided into two semesters: the first semester is from March 4 to July 19, 2024, and the second semester runs from August 19 to January 8, 2025. SKIS has seven periods of classes daily and each class is 50 minutes long.

Academic Curriculum

SKIS Middle & High School is accredited by the Korean Ministry of Education (MOE) and Singapore's Council for Private Education (CPE).

The school's highly qualified curriculum is centred around a ‘Glocal’ education, based on students’ Korean, global, and local identities, that aims to cultivate global talents of high character and intellect. SKIS achieves this by incorporating students’ Korean identities in their learning, implementing language and character education for global communication, and instilling a deep understanding of Singapore’s cultural characteristics in the students.

SKIS also boasts a ‘Bridge education’ with 4 main bridges that act as a foundation for learning:

1. Bridge of thought
Embracing each others’ opinions and pursuing original ideas.
2. Bridge of education
Integrating both a Korean and international system.
3. Bridge of heart
Creating a space where feelings are shared and ‘affection(정, 情)’ overflows.
4. Bridge of culture
Exploring various cultures whilst promoting Korean culture.

Self-Directed Learning

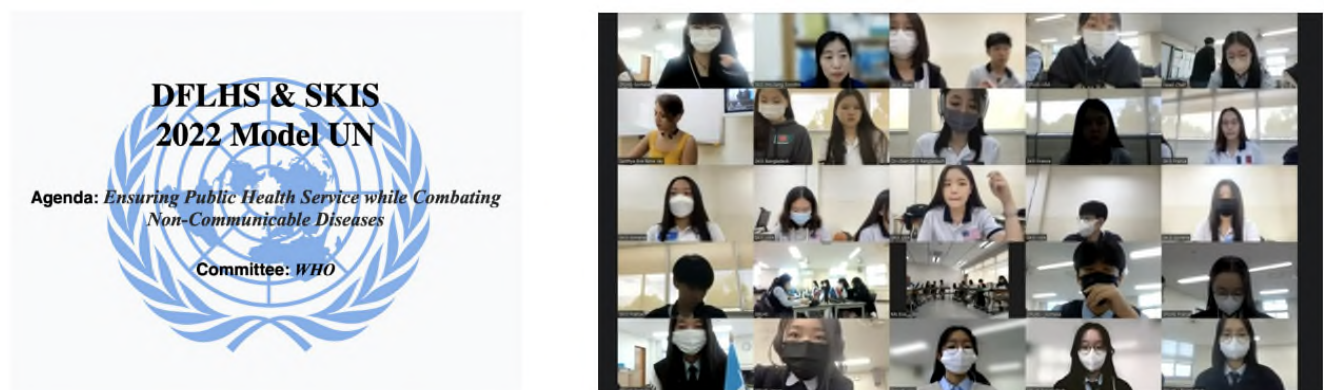
At SKIS, it is of cardinal importance that every student achieves his or her goals based on their personal interest and aptitude. SKIS helps students accomplish this by providing classrooms for independent night study so they can work towards their goals even during after-school hours. The school also arranges for capable students to take initiative and tutor others who need assistance in their learning through the Language Assistant and Peer Tutoring programs, further fostering a self-directed learning environment.

Model United Nations Contest



The Model United Nations (MUN) contest is a new event that has been added to SKIS's curriculum. All middle and high school students partake in a competitive essay competition and craft a piece of writing that addresses a global issue. A handful of students with the best essays are chosen from each grade and undergo a rigorous oral examination to test their natural speaking capabilities. Those who pass all tests are grouped into pairs and are given countries to represent as delegates. The students are then tasked with addressing a new global issue with a speech and a presentation. After the presentations, students from the audience have a time for asking meaningful questions to the presenting students.

International Exchange with Daejeon Foreign Language High School



Two years ago, high school students from the Model United Nations Contest event were given the opportunity to participate in an international exchange with Daejeon Foreign Language High School (DFLHS). During the exchange, SKIS students were grouped with students from DFLHS and tasked with collaborating, presenting, and discussing with each other on a specific agenda in the traditional MUN debate style. Through this experience, students from both schools were not only able to further hone their public speaking skills but also form special bonds in the process.

Golden Bell for Reunification



The Golden Bell for Reunification is a unique event held at SKIS. It is a twist on the popular Korean television program Golden Bell Challenge. However, instead of arbitrary subjects being quizzed, Golden Bell for Reunification specifically tests students on the topic of reunification between North and South Korea. The competition provides a special opportunity for students to acquire more knowledge about their country's history while engaging in friendly competition.

International Exchange with Singapore Nanyang Polytechnic(NYP)



Last year, high school students were given the opportunity to participate in an international exchange with Nanyang Polytechnic (NYP). During the exchange, both SKIS and NYP students participated in minhwa drawing, traditional Korean games, and K-pop dance. Through these experiences, students from both schools learned more about each other's culture, and they also became closer with students from different backgrounds.

SKIS Global Talent Award (High School)



The SKIS Global Talent Award is divided into 3 categories and celebrates students who have excelled in the various aspects of their school lives. There is the Global Scholastic Award, Global Achievement Award, and Global Volunteering Award. These awards are considered to be extremely prestigious as usually only one student is given more than one each year. Students have to meet the following strict criteria to attain the awards:

Global Scholastic Award (All three conditions must be satisfied):

- ▶ Grades that have an 'A' percentage of at least 70% for two terms or more throughout one's schooling at SKIS.
- ▶ A score of 110 and above on the TOEFL, HSK level 6, or JLPT level 1.
- ▶ A standardized test score which is within the top 1% such as a score of 1500 and above on the SAT or 34 and above on the ACT.

Global Achievement Award (Both conditions must be satisfied):

- ▶ A contribution to enhancing the school's reputation either on-campus or off-campus.
- ▶ An achievement of at least 3rd place in a national-level competition.

Global Volunteering Award (Only one of the two conditions needs to be satisfied):

- ▶ A completion of at least 200 hours of volunteering throughout one's high school years.
- ▶ Volunteer service extraordinary enough to be an example for others.

*For students from Korea, local schools, and international schools, volunteering hours from their previous high schools are included when counting.

Social Responsibility Program



The SKIS social responsibility program is specially curated to encourage students to take an active role in serving their community as responsible leaders of the future. These service activities allow students to better identify with others' needs and understand the importance of being socially responsible individuals. Moreover, the activities serve as chances to create long-lasting friendships and new-found bonds with others outside of a conventional learning environment. A vast majority of students register to be volunteers for school events or as teaching assistants at the SKIS Saturday School.

- ▶ SKIS Saturday School: Students serve as teaching assistants for Saturday elementary students
- ▶ Peer Tutoring: Students help each other study in this mentoring program
- ▶ Volunteering: Students volunteer to help at school events

Student Leader Activities



SKIS students elect class and school leaders in a direct vote process. Elected leaders provide leadership in organizing school events and foster a sense of democratic decision-making and collaboration. They often do the following:

- ▶ Organize and lead school events independently.
- ▶ Participate in Morning Duty: a morning campaign for safe and responsible school behavior.

Every week, high school students from different grades gather to work on their research projects. This type of Project-Based Learning (PBL) cultivates academic exploration skills through the research project process. Together, students learn how to choose topics, develop hypotheses, and conduct proper research and data collection. The students then carefully analyze the data, condense it, and present the results in their final presentation. Upon completion of the project, the students have the opportunity to foster a cooperative spirit by working with others, and they can strengthen core skills via the research project process.

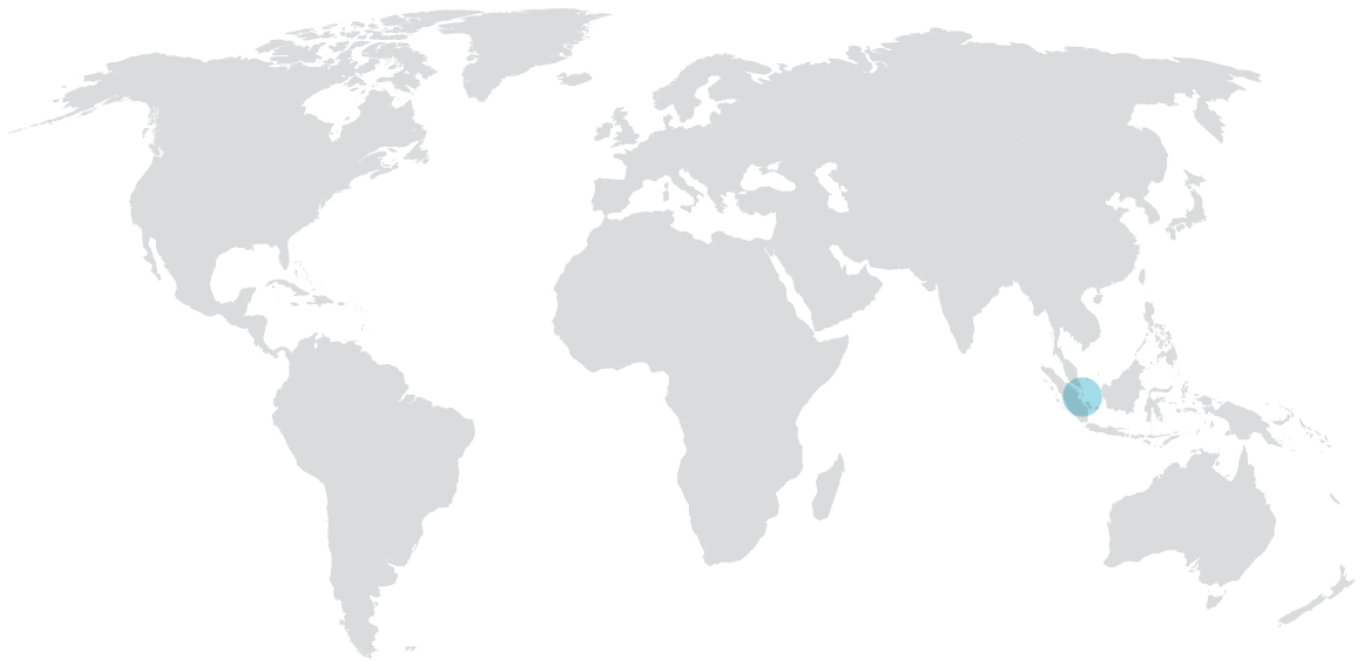
